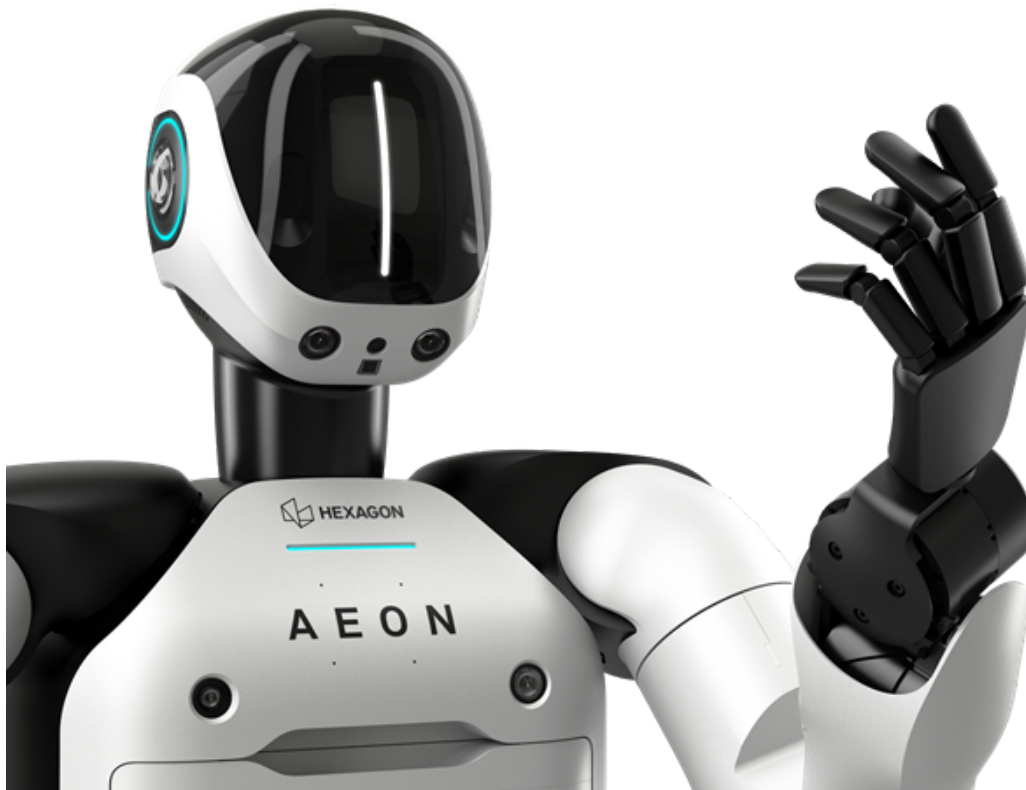




Working Student – Legal & Commercial Affairs (Master Level)
